Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

Supply of alcohol:

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the Premises licence-
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended
- 2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Exhibition of films

- 1. Where a premises licence authorises the exhibition of films, the licence must include a condition requiring the admission of children to the exhibition of any film to be restricted in accordance with this section.
- 2. Where the film classification body is specified in the licence, unless subsection (3)(b) applies, admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation by that body.
- 3. Where-
 - (a) the film classification body is not specified in the licence, or
 - (b) the relevant licensing authority has notified the holder of the licence that this subsection applies to the film in question,

admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by that licensing authority.

4. In this section "children" means any person aged under 18; and "film classification body" means the person or persons designated as the authority under section 4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984 (c39) (authority to determine suitability of video works for classification)

Door supervision

- 1. Where a premises licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- 2. But nothing in subsection 1. requires such a condition to be imposed
 - a) In respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or
 - b) In respect of premises in relation to -

- Any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising films or under a gaming licence, or
- II. Any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act.

For the purposes of this section, "security activity" means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to and occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- 1. The maximum permitted number of persons where provision for a close-seated audience is not intended shall be 275.
- 2. The maximum permitted number of persons where provision is made for a closeseated audience shall be either:-
 - (a) 240 when seating is arranged in one central block with gangway on all four sides with fifteen rows of seats with sixteen seats per row, or
 - (b) 210 when seating is arranged in two blocks, one of fourteen rows with six seats per row and one of fourteen rows with seven seats per row, with a central gangway and gangways on all four sides.
- 3. Members of the public shall not be permitted on to the gallery.

Embedded Restrictions

This Premises Licence is subject to the Regulations and Conditions adopted by Elmbridge Borough Council, and in force at the time of the granting of this licence, under Schedule 1 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982.
