

CLAYGATE VILLAGE HALL – COVID-19 CAPACITIES AND PERMITTED EVENTS.

Hirers are required to consider the vulnerability of their attendees to COVID-19 and organise their event accordingly, with care being taken to support attendance of the clinically extremely vulnerable who may still wish to maintain 2m social distancing and / or wear a face mask.

Hirers should also consider as part of their risk assessment the nature of the activity taking place in the Hall and the likelihood of transmission of COVID-19 as a result of their activity, (especially the generation of aerosols,) and determine the appropriate mitigations to put in place.

Government guidance recommends the following actions in order to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and other respiratory infections as part of learning to live safely with COVID-19.

1. Get vaccinated.
2. Let fresh air in if meeting others indoors.
3. Practise good hygiene:
 - wash your hands
 - cover your coughs and sneezes
 - clean your surroundings frequently
4. Wear a face covering or a face mask.
